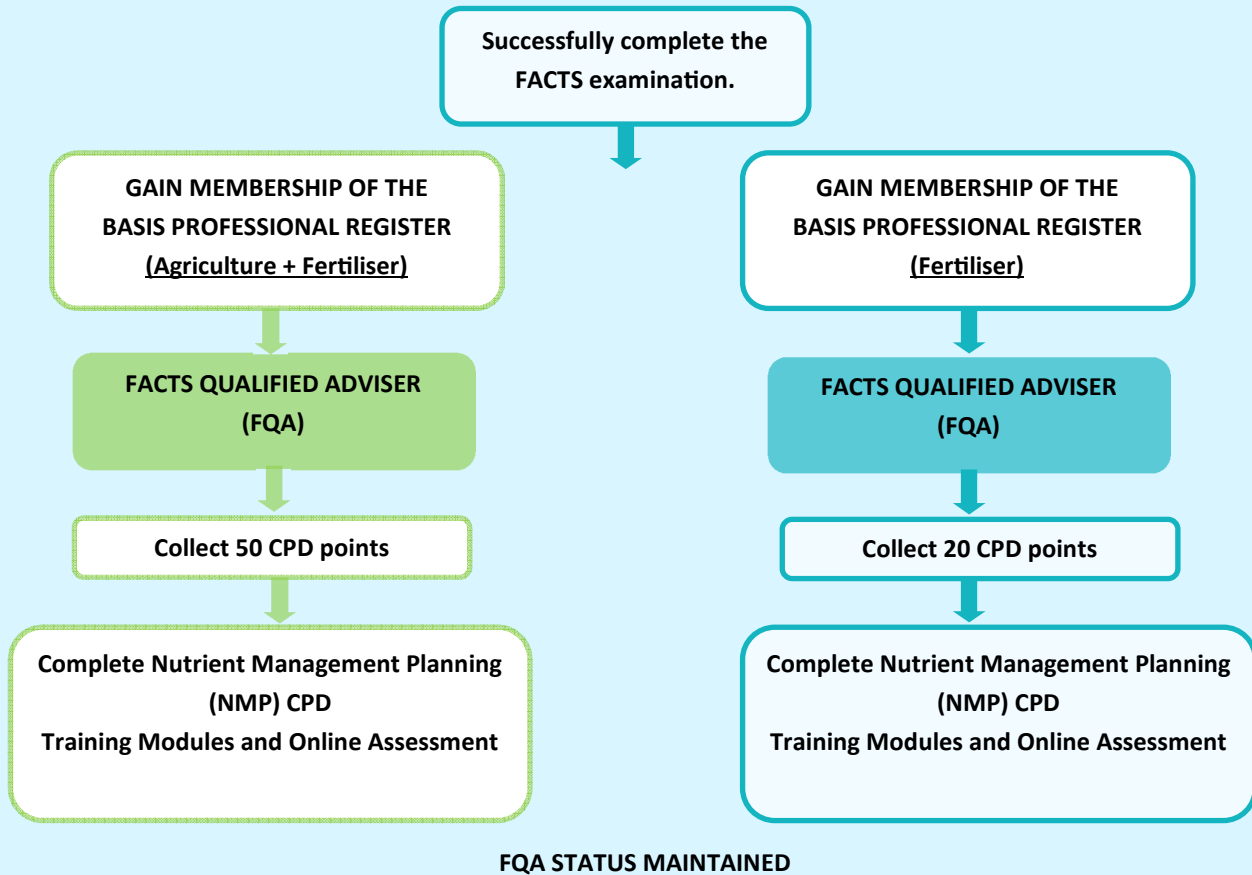


How to keep up to date

This leaflet will provide you with details on how to keep your FACTS Qualified Adviser status up to date following your FACTS examination.

HOW TO GAIN AND MAINTAIN FQA STATUS



NUTRIENT MANAGEMENT PLANNING (NMP) - key to holding onto FQA status

PEOPLE WHO WILL KEEP THEIR FACTS MEMBERSHIP

- The term **FACTS Qualified Adviser (FQA)** will only be given to those who have passed the FACTS examination and have taken the Nutrient Management Planning (NMP) training modules and assessment within two years of the exam date. Members also need to keep up to date with their BASIS Professional Register Membership.
- This will mean that everyone who is a FACTS Qualified Adviser will have to actively maintain CPD in future, (20 CPD points annually for Fertiliser and 50 CPD points for members who are on the register with Agriculture including Fertiliser). Only FQAs can offer advice on-farm.
